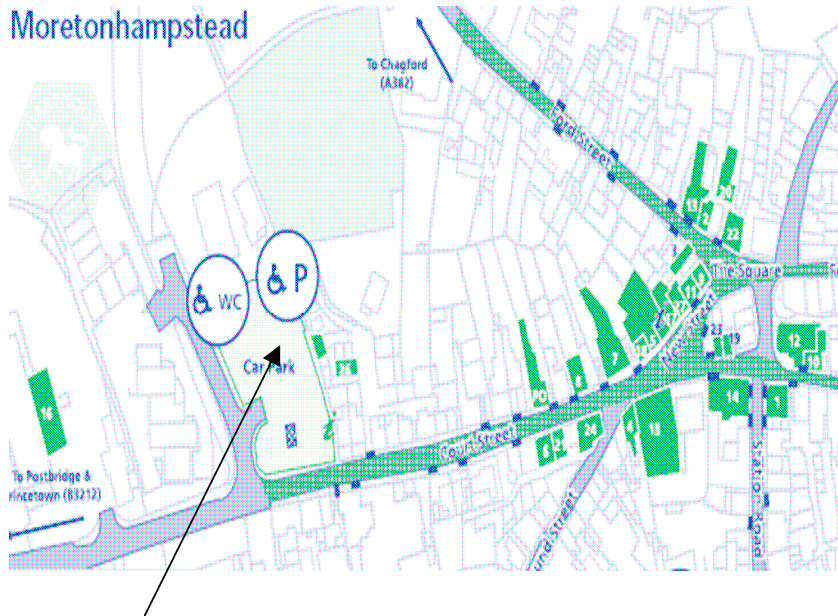


# Solar Hot Water Transformation Trail

# Solar Hot Water Transformation Trail

Ever thought of harnessing the power of the sun to generate hot water for your building? Join the Devon Association for Renewable Energy for a tour of sites across the Greater Dartmoor area that have harnessed the power of the sun to generate clean, green hot water. The day will consist of visiting four solar thermal panel arrays of differing scales, situations and applications. With the introduction of a renewable heat incentive scheduled for April next year there may be no better time to investigate installing solar panels and generating renewable hot water.

This tour will be lead by a DARE technical officer and each delegate will receive an information pack brimming with case studies, factsheets and data. The delegates will be transported by minibus to each site and will be able to ask the site owners questions about their technologies discovering the process from inspiration through to installation.

Are you a member of a community group who want to produce sustainable hot water for your community facility? Are you a householder who wants to reduce your carbon footprint? Are you a school with a roof area which could house solar panels? Or are you a local business who is concerned about fossil fuel supply and security? Do you have a swimming pool which you would like to heat through a renewable technology? We welcome all kinds of delegates to see these solar hot water installations in operation; the sites themselves include business, swimming pool, community and domestic examples.
